# Policy Assumptions - BCS

1) Projected growth plateau in 2014

6-8	260	12			
Total	620	27			


- 2) If split, break grades only at K-5 and 6-8
- 3) Preferred single location on 10 acre parcel
- 4) Facilities must include:

Gym

Library

Administrative Offices

Playgrounds





# Policy Assumptions - LASD


- 1) Maximum occupancy is 600 students per location
- 2) Location to be housed on 10/20 acre parcel for K-6/7-8
- 3) If split, break grades only at K-6 and 7-8 (Current Policy)
- 4) Facilities must include:

Gym

Library

Playgrounds





Alternatives

- 1. Shared Campus (BCS and LASD)
  - Status Quo @ Egan (add 2 story portables)
  - Another LASD school (split BCS into Elem/Middle)
- 2. Swap out LASD School
  - Small School (e.g. GB: move to other school/s)
  - Large School (buy/lease new Site for LASD)
- 3. Buy/Lease New Site for BCS
  - BCS K-8 on new site





### Factors to Consider

#### 1. Disruption

- Relocation of students
- Redrawing school boundaries to balance student enrollment

### Campus Issues

- Sharing of common area facilities (gyms, fields, etc.)
- Student density (> 600 students / campus)
- Mixed ages/grades on same campus (Elementary + Middle)


#### Costs

- Land acquisition costs (purchase/lease, LA vs LAH, various sites)
- Buildings (permanent structures, portables)

#### 4. Time

How long before school is fully functional







- Assume new site completed by 2013-14 school year (BCS plateau)




