


Proposed Agreement with Bullis


Background

- Prior to 2014, Annual Prop. 39 Process
 - Spent millions on lawsuits, annually divisive
- 2014: 5 year agreement, expires end of current school year
 - BCS enrollment cap of 900 in-district students
 - Facilities stability from enrollment certainty
- 2018: BCS and LASD meet several times re: new long term agreement
- November 1, 2019: BCS submitted Prop. 39 Facilities Request for 2019-20
 - Unilateral enrollment increase to 1,058 in-district students
 - Requests exclusive use of Egan for 2019-20 school year




Background

- February 1, 2019: LASD submits preliminary facilities offer to BCS
 - Expanded classroom space at Egan and Blach
 - Open additional shared spaces at Egan and Blach
 - Additional classrooms at Loyola for increased enrollment
- February 2019: Mediation resumes to seek a long term agreement
- April 2019: Mediation team proposes agreement to Board and community



Proposed Agreement Summary

- 10+ year agreement with BCS cap at 1,111 students (2019-20 projected enrollment)
- No earlier than 2023, BCS exclusive use of 16 of 18.83 acre Egan Junior High site
 - LASD preserves 2.83 acres for affordable teacher housing
- LASD constructs new Egan Campus at 10th site, open 2023 at the earliest




Proposed Agreement Summary

- Prior to Egan Junior High completion, BCS stays at Egan/ Blach; without expansion to other campuses
- Ends the divisive Prop. 39 process that has resulted in millions of dollars spent on lawsuits




Proposal Benefits to LASD

- Stops unchecked BCS growth by enforcing an enrollment cap
- Facilities stability without additional schools impacted beyond Blach and Egan, which already share
- Ends divisive, rigid Prop. 39 process and likely lawsuits
- Both sides compromise for the benefit of local students
- Satisfies LASD's obligations to BCS over the next
 10+ years without spending millions on facilities for them
- Keeps the Measure N promise: resolve school sharing and place 10 schools on 10 sites



Proposal Benefits to LASD Continued

- Gives LASD students exclusive use of their own campuses and protects our neighborhood schools
- Delivering peace to our community
- The new Egan campus will maximize taxpayer dollars by leveraging over \$100 million in contributions from developers and the City of Mountain View
- Preserves portion of the current Egan campus for LASD's future use to create teacher housing
