# HAND HYGIENE

Develop routines to ensure students wash their hands upon arrival, before/after recess & lunch, after bathroom use and after coughing/sneezing. Teach and reinforce proper handwashing technique with your class on a regular basis. <u>Videos | Handwashing</u>

### MAKE OR BUY FACE COVERS

When possible, face covers should be washed daily. Consider making or buying multiple face covers so you have time to wash them between use.

# **USE OF FACE COVERS**

Staff will be required to wear a face covering at all times, except when eating or drinking\* <u>How to Safely Wear and Remove a Face</u> <u>Covering</u>

### PERFORM DAILY SYMPTOM CHECKS

You will be required to check your temperature and symptoms each day before coming to work. If you have any signs of illness or a temperature of 99.6F or higher, you must stay home and notify your supervisor immediately. <u>COVID/Illness Screening</u>

### **KEEP PHYSICAL DISTANCE (6 FT)**

Maintain a distance of 6ft between you and students, when practicable, and other adults at all times.\* Consider having visual markers in your classroom as reminders. Assign stable seating arrangements.

## **REGULAR TESTING**

It is recommended that essential workers, including LASD employees, are tested on a monthly basis. We are currently in discussion with <u>El Camino</u> to see if we can establish a testing schedule for our staff. More details to come.

# **CLEANING AND DISINFECTING**

Complete the Keenan *Disinfectant Usage Training* by Sept 30<sup>th</sup>. You will be provided cleaning products and gloves to wipe high touch areas frequently throughout the school day. Custodial staff will provide daily disinfecting.

# PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

Staff will be provided with gloves, extra masks and faceshields for use as required.

#### CARE IN THE CLASSROOM

To maintain stable cohorts and minimize exposure, all classrooms will have a basic first aid kit to use. If you are uncertain or need guidance about student care- call the office before sending any student. Care in the classroom/ flowchart
